DESCRIPTION

This is our version of "day of coordination"

Clients are given our proprietary wedding planning resources we use to plan all of our Alaskan events.

The month of the wedding clients hand over their well laid plans to their coordinator who triple confirms all of the day-of details, runs the rehearsal, and manages the big day to ensure an easy breeze wedding full of fun.

THE WEDDING MANAGEMENT CLIENT

For the cost savvy client who wants to plan their own wedding, and have an on-site coordinator manage the rehearsal and wedding day so they can relax and party!

THIS SERVICE INCLUDES

- · Two consultations, meeting with coordinator
- First consultation: meet with your coordinator to write a detailed timeline, review our proprietary checklists and wedding planning resources specific to Alaskan venues and event needs
- Exclusive access to our rentals
- Final consultation (about 4 weeks out): finalize all details, and run through client's written plans. Coordinator will follow up and reconcile items with your vendors and family
- Detailed wedding day timeline creation and management for vendors, and a snapshot timeline for wedding party and family
- · Runs rehearsal
- · Coordinates vendors and manages onsite all wedding day details
- Manage set up and clean up crew (labor not included)



YOU HAVE QUESTIONS, WE HAVE ANSWERS

• HOW DO I BOOK YOUR SERVICES?

Ask for a proposal. We will send you an online booking link to make a deposit and sign our contract.

· DO YOU TRAVEL?

Yes, we regularly plan weddings between Homer, Juneau and Fairbanks and everywhere in between, across Alaska. We love to travel and travel often! Travel fees apply.

· CAN WE MEET FIRST?

We typically meet couples before they book. We have them complete an online questionnaire which allows us to quickly learn a little bit about them, and how they envision their wedding day unfolding. This meeting is helpful for both of us to know if we are a good fit!

I'VE BOOKED MOST OF MY VENDORS, I DON'T NEED MUCH WEDDING PLANNING HELP

Not really a question, but a sentiment we hear from time to time. Booking vendors does not equal wedding planning. Now that you have booked your vendors, you are just now getting into the real process. Planning really is the work involved after you have booked your vendors and now you need to answer their questions, ensure your expectations are met, and address key logistical issues specific to Alaska venues. DO YOU PROCESS PAYMENTS TO VENDORS?

One of the services we offer for full service planning clients is to process payments to vendors. You give us one large check and we distribute to vendors. If you are interested in this service, please see our full service planning packages.

CAN I PICK WHICH PLANNER OR COORDINATOR I WORK WITH?

Yes! Each of us have our own unique style and strengths. Please get to know us on our about page and blog, and let us know which of us you feel would be a better fit for you and we will check their availability.

· WILL YOU SET UP MY WEDDING?

Typically labor is in addition. Sometimes when couples have a very simple style, with minimal decor, and furniture is set by the venue, all you need is a coordinator or planner to set out your personal items.

· WILL YOU BE AT THE REHEARSAL?

Yes! All of our services include your planner or coordinator being at the rehearsal. Typically, we run the rehearsals, but sometimes the marriage commissioner or pastor will run the rehearsal. In those circumstances we are there to assist as needed.

· HOW MUCH EXTRA IS LABOR?

Labor varies greatly between events and depends on how many guests you have, if furniture needs to be set by laborers or by venue, what items are not provided by vendors and need us to cover it. An average wedding might have around \$1,000.00 in labor, but we have seen labor range between \$250.00 to \$5,000.00. We estimate and charge for labor at your final consult.

· WHAT IS YOUR PRODUCTION FEE?

Our planning fee is the service fee and pays your planner per hour based on an assumed amount of time they will be working with you during the planning process. The amount of guests at an event has a direct influence on the amount of work required of your onsite wedding manager. Our production fee is \$2.00 per guest and will be determined by the final guest count.

CAN I GIVE MY PLANNER MY DECORATIONS AT THE REHEARSAL TO DELIVER ON THE WEDDING DAY?

Your planner is available to deliver a limited amount of items on the wedding day to include: personal items provided to planner at the rehearsal; decor items rented through LBE; and items that the Client may have shipped up ahead of time.

WELCOME

Our welcome packet includes our proprietary resources: planning checklist and worksheets, specific to planning for Alaska venues; our step-by-step guide to getting married in Alaska; our preferred vendors, a list of vendors we have carefully vetted on your behalf; our wedding gratuity guide; our budget worksheets; and travel resources for out of town guests

FIRST MEETING

We get to know each other, discuss a potential timeline, review where you are in the planning process, make a plan for moving forward based on the service selected, and review our planning resources

CREATE MOOD BOARD

For services that include design, we further discuss your style though a design briefing. Rebecca will pull together color palettes, inspiration images and thematic elements into a mood board which is distributed to vendors so everyone is aesthetically aligned

BOOK VENUE AND VENDORS

We make additional and personalized recommendations for remaining vendors needed: based on getting to know you, your style and budget. Vendors are given a potential timeline and mood board to assist with accurate estimates

PLANNING MEETINGS AND COMMUNICATIONS

Depending on your service, we do a walk through of the venues to discuss set up and flow and take measurements in order to create a room diagram. We then have our planning meetings and exchange communications via email, text and phone calls to ensure all details are addressed. We have an extensive planning checklist which guides the planning process and a worksheet that is filled out as we go, detailing your decisions

TABLE PRESET

For services that include design, we pull together a selection of the items purchased or rented to include seating chart, menu cards, favors, chargers, table cloth and napkins and do a sample run through of your table scape to finalize colors and set up.

FINALIZE TIMELINE AND SET UP

At our final consultation we will review and finalize the timeline as well as how you envision the wedding day set up, look and feel. Your planner or coordinator takes the reigns while you enjoy the next 4 weeks or so, entertaining out of town guests and preparing for the big day

RECONCILE PLANS WITH VENDORS AND FAMILY

Your planner or coordinator will now follow up with each and every vendor and person involved, double and triple check each detail, and make any necessary adjustments well before the big day. A family timeline is created and distributed to wedding party and key family members

REHEARSAL

Your planner or coordinator will typically run the rehearsal, review with the wedding party etiquette and their role for the day, and answer any last minute questions before sending you off to enjoy your rehearsal dinner



WHAT IT LOOKS LIKE

TO WORK WITH US



DOORS OPEN

We are typically the first to arrive and open the building for set up, accept deliveries and check vendors in as they arrive. Ensure set up is going according to the timeline. Distribute gratuities to delivery drivers.

GETTING READY

Couples are getting ready with wedding party and close family, while we are running set up. If the bride is in close proximity to where the wedding planner is working, we will often deliver your bridal bouquet and bridesmaids bouquets to your getting ready room and check in with you

FIRST LOOK AND / OR FAMILY PHOTOGRAPHY

We pin boutonnieres on groom and groomsmen; and distribute corsages. Finalize ceremony details and double check flowers and decor are set up correctly

CEREMONY

Act as main point of contact for vendors and guests. Line family and wedding party up for the processional and send you down the aisle to get married. Work with photographer, officiant, and musicians to ensure we are keeping to timeline. Move guest book, gifts and cards to reception.

COCKTAIL HOUR

Act as main point of contact for vendors, make sure reception is set to open after cocktail hour, make sure bar and appetizers are ready and available for guests, answer guest questions and direct them to where they need to be. Ensure necessary items are moved from ceremony to reception and that the ceremony is torn down

OPEN RECEPTION

Invite guests to reception, assist guests to get seated, check in with vendors to keep to timeline and prepare for dinner service

GRAND ENTRANCE AND / OR WELCOME

Many couples choose to do a grand entrance, so we work with DJ and photographer to line up wedding party and couple for entrance, and connect DJ with anyone giving welcome speeches, prayers, etc.

DINNER SERVICE

We work with the caterer to ensure dinner is served on time, make sure bartenders are serving drinks, we typically make a plate of food for the couple and serve them, and dismiss tables through the buffet. We walk around the room and check on guests. Act as main point of contact and trouble shoot any issues

WEDDING TRADITIONS

We work with photographer and DJ to keep to timeline. Line up, and prepare couple, people giving toasts, parent's for family dances and cutting the cake



WHAT A WEDDING DAY

OFTEN LOOKS LIKE

DANCING

While you are busy dancing with your friends, we will check on you from time to time. We ensure the ceremony and cocktail hour have been torn down. We will put away the welcome table items and put out the thank you favors for guests to take as they leave. We typically pack up your wedding gifts and cards and either send them to your room or secure them in a family member's vehicle. Vendors are starting to leave in waves, so we are distributing gratuities on your behalf and checking them out. We secure the top tier of your wedding cake, and pack up your personal items such as special toasting glasses and wedding cake cutting set. We pack up any other personal items that are no longer being used and start getting organized for tear down

GRAND EXIT

We will arrange couple and guests for grand exit if any, and work with DJ to ensure a seamless experience

LAST CALL / LAST DANCE

We work with DJ and bar to close out the night with guests. We bring up the lights and turn down the music, giving guests a few minutes to finish conversations and drinks. Give designated family your last personal items, have them boxed up and ready to load up

HARD CLOSE

Start tearing down event, laborers are stacking furniture and decor for vendor pick up, we are sorting personal items and packing away, and managing labor team. Distribute remaining gratuities. Close up the venue.

CLOSE OUT VENDORS

Ensure all items were returned to vendors, follow up if needed
